HOW TO SET UP MFA FOR YOUR MMU **MICROSOFT 365 ACCOUNT**

This guide is for students and staff accounts. Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) helps protect your account by requiring a code from your phone in addition to your password.

1 Sign in to Your Microsoft 365 Account a) Go to https://portal.office.com and sign in with your MMU email and password Microsoft. Sign in Sign-in options b) Enter your MMU email (e.g., yourlD@student.mmu.edu.my) and password.

On iPhone, you may be asked to allow camera access the first time you scan a QR code, and to allow notifications. The steps and options are otherwise the same as on Android, but the interface may look slightly different.
